At home, Dan helps his parents home chores together with his sister. Their mother mother is very happy and promises to take them for a tour at the game park.




Dan's mum cooks him a nice meal. He loves chapati and chicken curry. He shares the food with his friends. Dan is generous and loves his friends.




On Sunday, Dan accompanies his parents to the church. He fears God and respects Him. He prays before sleeping and early in the morning before waking up.




